

FINANCIAL POSITION

Thanks to the enormous generosity of our congregations and those affiliated with Naremburn Cammeray Anglican Church, we have received donations and pledges for future donations that have enabled us to proceed with the project. As at June 2008 this had totalled \$2.8 million. We have also received a \$0.5 million grant from the Sydney Anglican Diocese Mission Property Committee. However the total cost of the project is estimated at \$3.7m so we still need your help to ensure that we pay off the project entirely.

YOUR INVOLVEMENT

We are asking people to consider what they may give in each financial year to June 2010. At some stage during this period a loan will be used to complete payment to the builder. We would like to pay off the loan as soon as possible and not burden future members of the parish with an outstanding debt.

TAX DEDUCTIBILITY

Because the Parish Ministry Centre will be used primarily for Christian Education purposes (Bible Study, Sunday School and School of Ministry) it has been registered with the tax office and all donations over \$2 are tax deductible.
