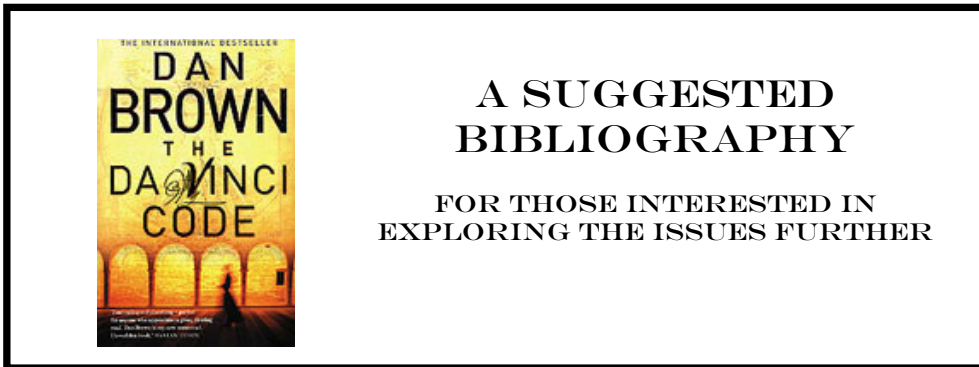

An easy read and introductory text to the historicity of the NT period.

An easy to read introduction to the historicity of the NT and the resurrection.
