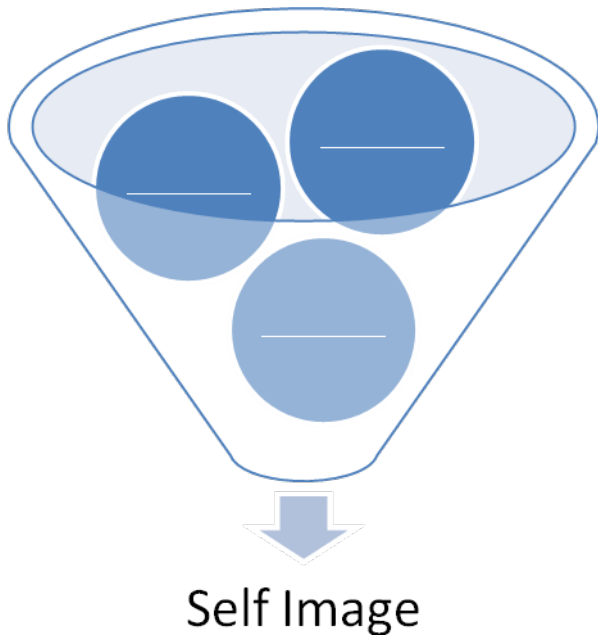

Our view of others	<p>Eg. A consumer mentality to relationships.</p> <p>People are accessories to my image.</p> <p>Spend a lot of my time comparing myself to others.</p> <p>Faults in others drive me crazy.</p>	
Our view of God	<p>I present him with a list of things I want and he fills my order.</p> <p>Despise Christ for his weakness.</p>
