

A NEW MISSIONARY PARTNERSHIP

As a church we have always looked for opportunities to connect with our community. For the last 10 years we have recognized that one of the biggest opportunities in this region is outreach into the Japanese community.

There are around 10,000 long term Japanese speaking residents in Sydney, the vast majority living in our region. There are also over 600,000 temporary Japanese residents (tourists, students, and those here on business). Each Saturday, large numbers of Japanese children (often accompanied by their parents) gather from around Sydney at Cammeray Primary School for Japanese tutorial lessons.

Our Partnership with the Sydney Japanese Evangelical Church has seen a small Church service meeting at Cammeray every Sunday afternoon at 2pm. The commencement of the 'Narnia Cafe' last year has enhanced Japanese outreach into the community.

Now, after 18 years missionary work in Japan, Grahame and Cathy Smith and family have returned, and are ideally suited to taking up the leadership of this work.

I commend this new pioneer missionary venture to your prayers and financial support.
